- Volunteer in my child's classroom.
- Check my child's book bag at the end of each school day.

- Attend school regularly, prepared to work with paper, pencils, books, and homework.
- Discuss with my parent(s)/guardian(s) what I am learning in school.
- Limit my TV viewing and use time wisely.

- Visit the public or school library at least once a week.
- Show a positive attitude about learning.
- Complete homework assignments to the best of my ability.
- Read with an adult or an older sister or brother often.
