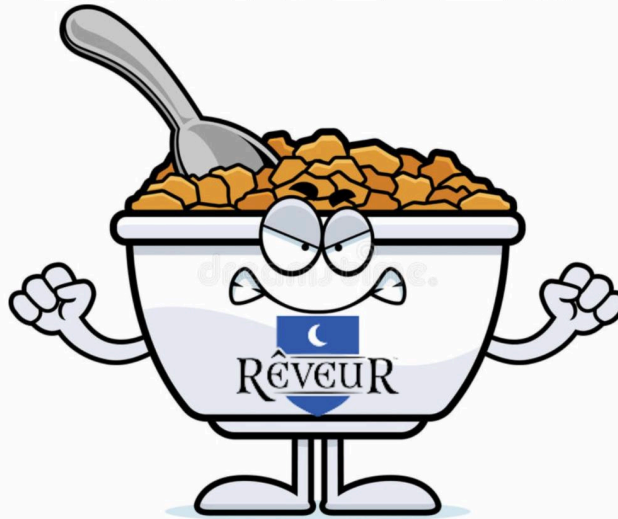

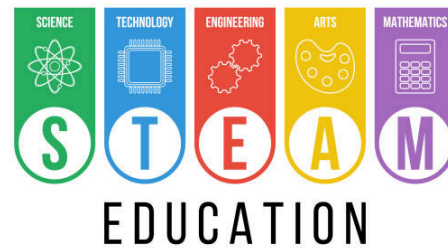

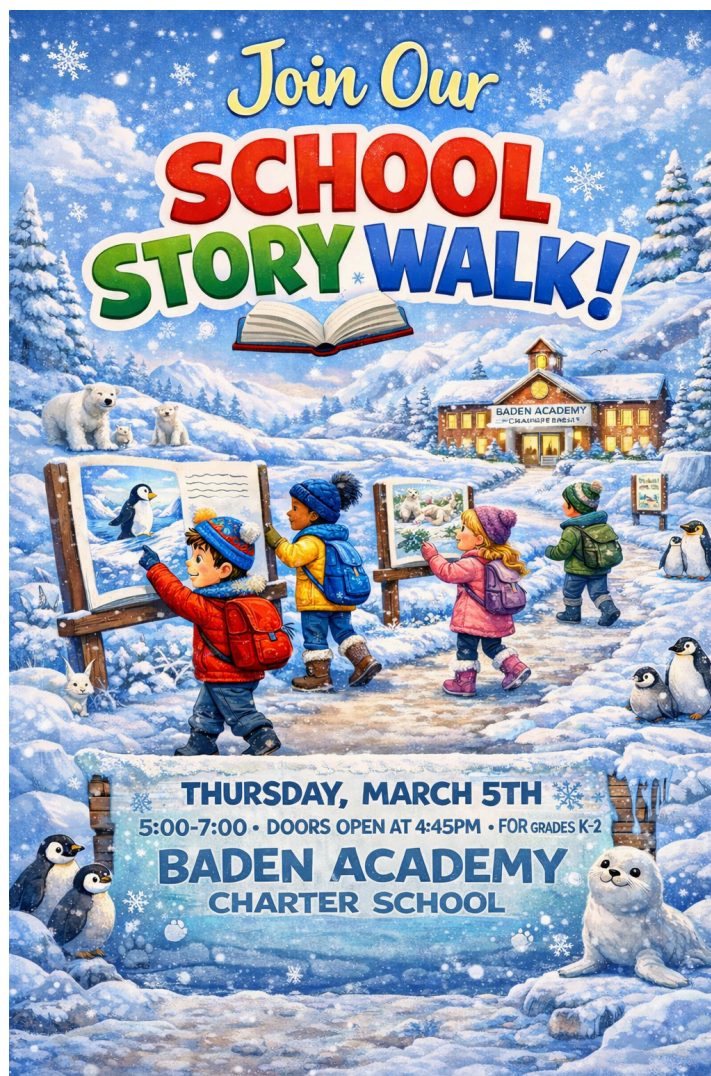

Looking Ahead

Parenting Workshop - Managing Behaviors

The Beaver Valley Intermediate Unit (I.U. #27) is offering a free two-part training series focused on helping parents, guardians, caretakers, and agency workers better understand and manage challenging behaviors they may see in children and young adults. **This free training will be in-person on Wednesday, April 15th and Wednesday, April 29th, from 5:00-7:00 pm at the Beaver Valley Intermediate Unit (147 Poplar Avenue, Monaca, PA 15061).**



The content for each session will be different. These training sessions will investigate why children misbehave and how to effectively, appropriately, and therapeutically de-escalate these behaviors. Topics include the decision making process during de-escalation, the conflict cycle, childhood trauma and its impact on the youth, and adult anger traps/diminishing power struggles. All attendees must be at least 18 years of age.
