The Importance of Being On Time to School



Arriving at school on time sets the tone for a successful day of learning! When students are punctual, they start their day with a positive mindset, stay on track with their lessons, and build good habits for the future. Being on time also helps children feel more connected to their classmates and teachers, fostering a sense of belonging and responsibility.

As outlined in the Baden Academy Student Handbook, students are expected to be in their first-period class by 8:55 AM, and daily attendance is taken at 9:00 AM. Any student arriving after 8:55 AM will be considered tardy, regardless of entry time into the building. Upon arrival, students must report to the main office for a late slip, which must be presented to their classroom teacher. Parents/guardians are required to sign their children into school if they are late.

Please note that one unexcused tardy or early dismissal equals 0.2 unexcused absences, and accumulating five unexcused tardies or early dismissals results in 1 unexcused absence. Punctuality is crucial for student success, as tardiness can impact academic progress and lead to challenges in catching up with classmates.

Let's work together to ensure our students develop strong routines that support their academic success and personal growth. Every minute counts—let's make the most of each school day!


WHERE: AUDITORIUM

If you cannot attend in person, the Baden Academy Charter School facebook page will have a live feed, as well as a recorded video of the performance.








Rehearsal Schedule




