Dear Parents/Guardians,

To help keep our students safe, we are required by Pennsylvania law to conduct an intruder safety drill within the first 90 days of school. Our practice drill will take place on Friday, October 10th.

Teachers will explain the procedures to students ahead of time so they understand what to expect. We know that drills like this can sometimes cause worry, so we will conduct it in a calm, age-appropriate way, with plenty of support and reassurance from staff.

The goal of this practice is to make sure everyone knows what to do in the unlikely event of an emergency, while keeping the atmosphere as positive and supportive as possible.


