## From the School Counselor

Hello BACS Families,

Happy New Year! I hope everyone enjoyed their winter break. This month in Guidance we will be discussing Goal Setting and Grit. These are skills that help children plan, persevere, and keep going even when something feels challenging. Goal setting teaches kids how to identify what they want to achieve, break it into manageable steps, and reflect on their progress. Grit helps them understand that mistakes and setbacks are a normal part of learning, not a reason to give up. Together, these skills build confidence, responsibility, and resilience that students can carry into academics, friendships, and life beyond school.

Parents can support this learning at home by encouraging children to set **their own age-appropriate goals**, whether it's improving a grade, practicing a skill, or building a healthy habit. Help them break big goals into smaller steps, celebrate effort (not just outcomes), and talk openly about challenges they encounter along the way. When children see adults modeling perseverance and positive self-talk, they learn that success comes from consistent effort and a willingness to try again. 




