- Review the policies, standards, assessments,

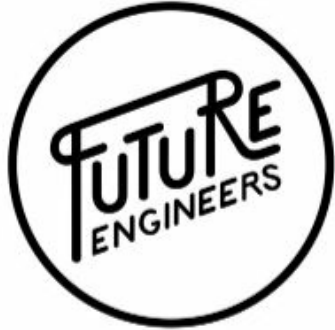

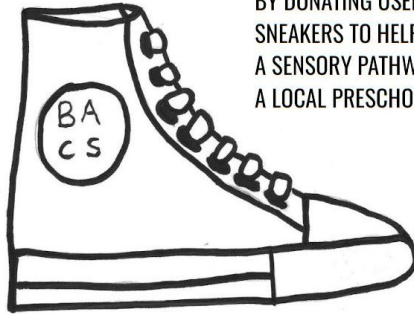
We Want Your Used Tennis Shoes!
