April House Meeting

Sol Lewitt (1928 – 2007) was an American artist who was a pioneer of the conceptual art movement. Of this movement, Lewitt said:

“In conceptual art the idea or concept is the most important aspect of the work. When an artist uses a conceptual form of art, it means that all of the planning and decisions are made

beforehand and the execution is a perfunctory affair. The idea becomes a machine that makes the art."

One of Lewitt's main interests in conceptual art was exploring and building with cubes, both two dimensional on paper and through three dimensional structures. Lewitt's cubes gained popularity and his cube artwork is found in many museums throughout the USA. It was his cube artwork that helped to inspire the 1980's arcade game, Q-Bert.

At our last house meeting, each house worked to create a mural based off the Lewitt cubes. Each student received a piece of cardstock with a cube drawn on it. The top of the cube was pre-colored to match the color of the student's house. The other two sides featured designs drawn by the students that correlated with the monthly SEL theme on self-management.

We will post the final project when it is complete!

These events include a homecoming event for the entire community. This event will have a family fun run, art fest, performances from alumni and students, crafts, food vendors, and more!



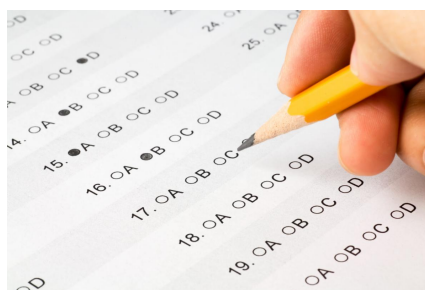
