SCHOOL LOTTERY INFORMATION

Applications for next school year <u>ARE NOW LIVE</u>, should you need to apply for any *new siblings*. Current enrolled students do not need to reapply! Please read our policy on lottery and preference for applicants.

As a public charter school, our admissions process includes the completion of a digital and random lottery, through which we identify students to be offered a slot for the upcoming school year. The lottery for *Kindergarten* will be conducted on January 23, 2025. Students in older grades will form a wait list until the end of the current school year until we see how many available spots we have.

Should we receive more applicants than the number of expected open seats for the upcoming school year, students who were not selected in the initial lottery are placed on a waitlist and offered admissions as seats become available.

During the lottery, the nature of our charter requires that we give preference to applicants for the lottery (for the upcoming school year) in the following order:

- Siblings of existing BACS students from the Ambridge Area School District
- · Siblings of existing BACS students from all other districts
- · Family members of BACS founders in the Ambridge Area School District
- · Family members of BACS founders from all other districts
- Students from the Ambridge Area School District
- Students from all other districts

During open enrollment (for the current school year, or for the upcoming school year after the lottery has been completed), admissions are handled on a first-come, first-serve basis.

What should parents know about Roblox?

Roblox is a popular online platform where kids can create and play games, but it also comes with potential risks that parents should understand. By using built-in safety features and actively monitoring their child's activity, parents can help ensure a safer and more enjoyable experience.

- Platform Overview: Roblox is a game-creation site where users design, upload, and play games in a multiplayer environment.
- Age Recommendation: Rated for ages 13+ due to issues with inappropriate content. Younger kids may use it safely with restrictions and close parental supervision.
- Chat and Communication: Chats and posts are filtered for users under 13, but disabling chat is recommended for additional safety.
- Account Security: Set a 4-digit PIN to prevent kids from altering settings, and restrict access to a curated list of age-appropriate games.
- Content Risks: Reports of inappropriate messages, predatory behavior, and unsuitable game content (violence, adult language, sexual themes).
- Commercial Elements: Kids can purchase or earn Robux, and premium memberships allow trading and selling items.
- Privacy Considerations: Review the privacy policy and ensure settings align with your comfort level. Parents can submit a "Do Not Sell" request under CCPA.
- Parental Guidance: Use tools like Roblox's security features and stay informed through resources like the Ultimate Guide to Roblox.






