Costume Guidelines

Costumes are optional, but all students who choose to participate must follow these rules.

Students should arrive at school already wearing their costumes. No full costume changes will be permitted during the day.

Costumes must be school-appropriate and follow dress code expectations for modesty and safety.

Not Permitted

No weapons or weapon-like props — this includes toy guns, swords, knives, axes, or similar items.

No violent, inappropriate, or mature themes.

No costumes that include offensive or culturally insensitive elements.

Makeup and Accessories

Light face paint is fine, but it should not interfere with classroom activities or make a mess.

Accessories must be safe and easy to carry or wear — nothing sharp, oversized, or breakable.

During the School Day

Costumes should allow students to sit comfortably, walk safely, and participate in learning activities.

Students must still be able to use the restroom independently while in costume.

Teachers or administrators may ask a student to remove or modify a costume piece if it becomes disruptive or unsafe.

Please label any removable items (like hats or accessories) with your child's name.

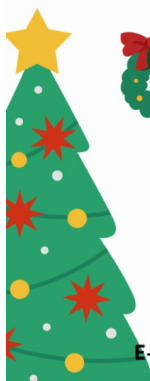
