Looking Ahead

Parent's Guide to Safe & Responsible TikTok Use

As we continue to prioritize the safety and well-being of our students, we want to provide guidance on TikTok, one of the most popular social media platforms among young people. While TikTok can be an entertaining and creative outlet, it also comes with challenges that families should be aware of. Suggested Rules and Appropriate Use of TikTok:



1. **Age Recommendation:** TikTok is recommended for users 13 years and older, as outlined in the platform's terms of service. If children under 13 are using the app, we encourage close parental supervision and consideration of age-appropriate alternatives.
2. **Set Time Limits:** Encourage students to limit their daily screen time on TikTok to balance schoolwork, extracurriculars, and family time. Tools within the app allow parents to set screen time limits.
3. **Privacy Settings:** Ensure that your child's TikTok account is set to *private* to control who can view their content and send them messages.
4. **Monitor Content:** Check in regularly on what your child is watching and creating. Discuss appropriate and inappropriate content openly with them.
5. **Teach Responsible Posting:** Remind students that once something is posted, it stays online forever. Encourage them to think before sharing personal information, photos, or videos.
6. **Encourage Positive Use:** Promote TikTok as a space for creativity, learning, and fun. There are educational videos, art showcases, and inspiring content that can encourage students to develop new skills or interests.
7. **Know the Risks:** Talk to your children about harmful trends, cyberbullying, and unsafe challenges. Let them know it's okay to come to you if they feel uncomfortable with anything they see online.

TikTok has a *Family Pairing* feature that allows parents to link their account to their child's to manage screen time, content, and privacy settings. You can find more information about TikTok on [Common Sense Media](#).

We encourage families to stay involved in their children's digital lives. By working together, we can ensure that platforms like TikTok are used responsibly and safely.

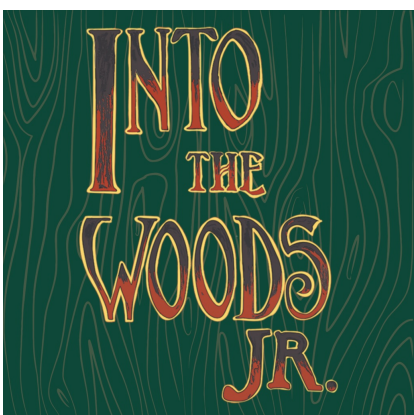

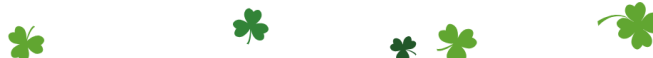

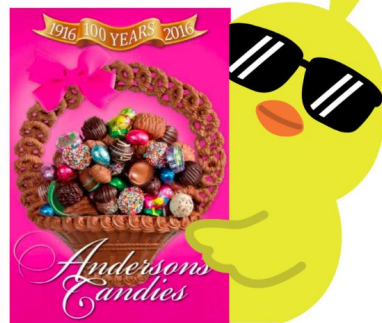
