Medication Form

medication policy. Both federal and state laws apply to medication administration in public schools. Parent(s)/guardian(s) should administer medications at home whenever possible and should collaborate with their primary care provider to establish medication schedules that minimize administration at school.

For each medication to be administered a medication order from a licensed prescriber is needed. A prescription provides instruction to the pharmacist for dispensing the medication, while a medication order provides instruction to the nurse for administration of the medication. These are 2 different things.

Please see the attached form that is needed for a student to receive medication at school.

Medication orders are required for both prescription as well as over-the-counter medications and herbal remedies.

All medication must arrive at school in its original container.

For example, DO NOT send in a single dose of medication, in a container/baggie from home. We have no idea of knowing what this liquid or pill/capsule is, nor are we allowed to administer it.

Also, if your student is receiving drops for "pink eye", they can be administered at home around school hours. Most medications can be administered around school hours. Your doctor will let you know if the medicine needs to be administered at school and they also know what paperwork is needed for this to happen. Your co-operation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

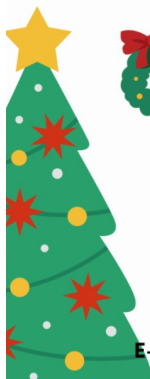
